3) Gather monthly with other retreatants to learn more about the Spiritual Exercises and for faith shar ing.

This is how Nicholas Brouillard from St. Francis Xavier Parish experienced the Spiritual Exercises: "I began the Spiritual Exercises in Everyday Life (SEEL) retreat wanting a more intimate and structured prayer life. Being so open and honest with my director was a bit of a struggle at first. But once I found out about Ignatian discernment and indifference, I was 100% sold. Now I have a more personal relationship with Christ, a structure for prayer that helps me stay in the moment, and several new friends!"
