Diocesan Directive Update

- As per the Diocesan liturgical guidelines effective June 5th the obligation to attend Sunday & Holy Days will resume. *This does not apply to those who are vulnerable.*
- The following are rescinded:
 - The use of hymnals
 - Holy Water in fonts
- The following remain suspended:
 - Exchange of the sign of peace
 - Communion under the form of the Precious Blood
- We will continue to live-stream the 10:00 am Mass and Reidy Hall will be open ONLY during the 10:00 am Mass for those wishing to social distance.

- **Catechesis of the Good Shepherd** In our Atriums we have “Practical Life Materials.” These materials teach care for one’s self, care of one’s environment, confidence in movement and social relations. They help the child to develop concentration. They give the child a task that she or he can complete successfully “all by myself.” This lays a foundation for all subsequent activities, and for daily life in general. This September, we will add to our Level 1 Atrium for 3 to 5 year olds a new Level 2 Atrium for children ages 6 to 9. We invite you to discover more!
- **Memorial Day Mass at Noon followed by a picnic!**
The Knights of Columbus will be cooking Hamburgers and hot dogs we invite you to bring a side dish or a dessert to share. Please note we will not be having a 8:00 am Mass on the 31st.
- **Ministers of Care** We are now allowed, once again, to bring Communion to peoples’ homes. If you or someone you know is interested in having a Minister of Care bring Eucharist, or if you are interested in being part of this ministry, please let Pam know in the parish office. At this time, assisted living homes are not yet allowing this type of visit.
