## Diocesan Directive Update

- As per the Diocesan liturgical guidelines effective June 5th the obligation to attend Sunday & Holy Days will resume. *This does not apply to those who are vulnerable.*
- The following are rescinded:
  - The use of hymnals
  - Holy Water in fonts
- The following remain suspended:
  - Exchange of the sign of peace
  - Communion under the form of the Precious Blood
- We will continue to live-stream the 10:00 am Mass and Reidy Hall will be open ONLY during the 10:00 am Mass for those wishing to social distance.

- **Catechesis of the Good Shepherd** In the Atrium you will hear the word “WORK”. The activities in the Atrium, like work, have an intelligent purpose and give dignity to the child.
