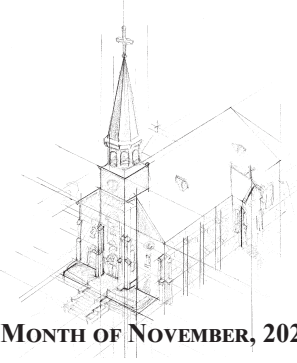

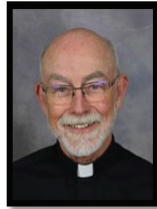

- **Return of the Cup** -Starting the 1st Sunday of Advent, we will bring back the Cup of the most Holy Sacrament. Extraordinary Ministers of the Cup will stand to the side for distribution of the consecrated wine. As you come forward for Communion, please be aware that there are two stations for distribution of the consecrated hosts and one for the Cup. After receiving, another worshipper, might be walking behind you to the other station or to the Cup station; please be aware of your surroundings. The proper way to receive Communion is by the hand or by the tongue while standing. For the Cup, if you wish to receive, do so, if you do not wish to receive from the Cup, simply return to your seat. For those receiving from the Cup, Intinction (dipping the host into the consecrated wine) will not be an option.
